Subject: Regarding ensuring strict abidance of order issued to Nursing Homes/Clinical Establishments for capped rate list.

**References: 1. Directions of Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition no 8914/2020

In order to prohibit overcharging by the registered nursing homes/clinical establishments, the State in exercise of the powers conferred as per the enabling provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Madhya Pradesh Public Health Act, 1949, the Madhya Pradesh Upcharyagriha Tatha Rujopchar Sambandhi Sthapnaye (Registrikaran Tatha Anugyapan) Adhinyam, 1973, the Madhya Pradesh Atyavashyak Seva Sandharan Tatha Vichchinnata Nivaran Adhinyam, 1979, the Madhya Pradesh Upcharyagriha Tatha Rujopchar Sambandhi Sthapnaye (Registrikaran Tatha Anugyapan) Rules, 1997 and the Madhya Pradesh Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 has issued following direction:-

"The State Government directs that treatment charges for COVID-19 patients availing treatment at all the Private Hospitals/Nursing Homes/Clinics shall be as per the rate list [Schedule II and III of Rules 2017 of the Madhya Pradesh Upcharyagriha Tatha Rujopchar Sambandhi Sthapnaye (Registrikaran Tatha Anugyapan) Rules, 1997] communicated to the Chief Medical and Health Officer of the respective district on or before 29th of February 2020. Under no circumstances, the Nursing Home or Clinical Establishment charges shall exceed by 40% of the rates communicated on or before 29th of February, 2020 including all expenses such as PPE Kits etc."

All registered Nursing Home/Clinical Establishments are mandated to furnish the details of prevalent rate list at the time of registration which is perusable on <https://nhs.mponline.gov.in/portal/services/nhs/frmLogin.aspx>. As per the mandate of the Madhya Pradesh Upcharyagriha Tatha Rujopchar Sambandhi Sthapnaye (Registrikaran Tatha Anugyapan) Rules, 1997, rate list and amendments (if any) shall need to be communicated to the supervising authority. Hence, instances of non-compliances may be established by comparing the present rates with


the rates communicated before 29th of February, 2020.

In case of observed/reported non-compliance by the registered private nursing homes/clinical establishment immediate action to be ensured under relevant Acts and Rules.
